### Traffic and Parking Survey

The Parish Council instructed ITS Global to undertake a parking survey and ITS produced an Issues and Options document. The Parish Council carried held two consultation evenings to enable residents to comment on the document and also carried out an extensive survey. At the July Parish Council Meeting, Members resolved to discuss the proposals with Kent Highways. Cllr Jeffery is working with Cllr Roy (District) and Kent Highways to update the Council's Highways Improvement Plan (HIP) and agree the next actions.

### A225 Roadworks

The Parish Council has been liaising constantly with Kent Highways and Cllr Marc Logen (County) to try and mitigate the congestion in Shoreham with the placing of parking cones.

### Family Fun Day
